What is Day Camp?

Day Camp is a Christ-centered, outdoor adventure for children who have completed grades 1–5 and includes Bible lessons, swimming, canoeing, games, crafts, friends and fun!

Where is Day Camp located?

Day Camp takes place at Whispering Pines Christian Camp, which is located on 60 beautiful, wooded acres on Old Hickory Lake near Castalian Springs, Tennessee. The camp facilities are owned and operated by Hendersonville Church of Christ.

What is a typical day like?

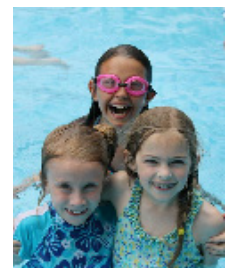
The daily schedule includes:

- Bus trip to and from camp
- Prayer, devotional and Bible lessons
- Lunch and snacks
- Crafts and quiet games
- Outside team sports
- Nature study
- Swimming, canoeing and fishing
- Clean-up

Every day is packed with time for your child to learn and grow closer to God and time to have fun with other campers!

Who supervises Day Camp?

Day Camp is under the direction of Holley Sisk and Megan Hester, teachers in Sumner County and members of Hendersonville Church of Christ. They are assisted by a friendly, trained staff of high school students who make every effort to ensure each camper has a safe and enjoyable learning experience. A Registered Nurse is at camp at all times and a Red Cross-certified lifeguard is on duty for all water activities.



How much does it cost?

Day Camp 1\$100 per camper
Includes transportation, snacks, drinks, craft supplies, camp T-shirt

Day Camp 2.....\$115 per camper
Includes transportation, snacks, drinks, craft supplies, camp T-shirt, dinner and lodging Thursday evening, breakfast Friday morning

How do I register my child for Day Camp?

1. Beginning April 12, register for Day Camp at Hendersonville.org/DayCamp
2. Payments may be submitted online with your registration or a check payable to "Hendersonville Church of Christ" can be brought to the Church Office.
3. A Consent to Participate form must be signed by a parent/legal guardian in the presence of a notary. Free notary services are available in the Church Office.

Information for Day Camp 2

Day Camp 2 includes one overnight stay on Thursday night at Whispering Pines Christian Camp. This is designed to provide campers with a taste of what Big Camp (a week-long, overnight camp for middle and high school students) is like. Students are eligible for Big Camp when they complete 6th grade.



On Thursday, campers arrive as usual in the morning but should be prepared to spend the night at camp that evening. They need basic toiletries, overnight clothes and clothes for Friday. In addition, they need a pillow and either a sleeping bag or sheets and blanket.

Thursday evening operates like a night at Big Camp. Campers have dinner together, a special worship time, play games or have some type of entertainment, have a campfire devotional and evening snack. Girls stay in the lodge and boys stay in the bunkhouse. Both facilities are air conditioned and secure. Holley Sisk, Day Camp Director, and Megan Hester, Assistant Director, as well as counselors and other adults are in attendance that night.

On Friday morning campers have an abbreviated day and return to the Church Gym at 10am.

What does my child need to bring?

Each day your child needs to bring:

- A sack lunch (we supply drinks; be sure your child's lunch is labeled with his or her name)
- Water bottle
- Swimsuit and towel
- Extra pair of shorts
- Old shoes for lake purposes (they will get wet!)
- On Friday, it is important that you pack an extra change of clothes (shirt, pants or shorts, undergarments and shoes)

Place all items in a backpack or tote bag labeled with the camper's name.

Do not bring cell phones, iPads, tablets or any other electronic devices.
